What? About 50 grants are available in the 2007/08 academic year, valued at 10,000 - 60,000 FCFA and payable in February 2008 through the Community Credit Company in Cameroon.

Grants are available on a competitive basis to Moghamo students in secondary grammar, commercial and technical schools and as well as high schools, higher vocational colleges and universities.

Who can apply? At least one parent of applicant must be a native of Ambo, Angie, Anong, Ashong, Batibo, Bessi, Bessom, Efah, Enwen, Enyoh, Ewai, Guzang, Kugwe, Kurabei, Kuruku, Mbengok, Mbunjei, Ngyen-Muwa, Numben, Nyenjei, Oshum or Tiben.

When? Submit a completed and signed application form together with copy of birth certificate (1st time applicants only) and latest report card or GCE results slip or university transcript, to the MEDA USA Scholarships Representative in Yaoundé:
